This Indenture, ^{made} This thirtieth day of December in the Year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Between Joshua Johnson Elarah his wife of the one part of Wake County in North Carolina and Abridgeton Jones joint of Southwarrington County in Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joshua Johnson and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the first sum of One hundred and thirty five pounds Current money to them in hand paid by the said Abridgeton Jones sum at or before the Ensigning and Delivery of these presents The receipt whereof the said Joshua Johnson and Sarah his wife (Both hereby Acknowledge) they the said Joshua and Sarah his wife I have granted Bargained sold Alien released, confirmed and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell, alien, release Deliver & Confirm unto the said Abridgeton Jones joint & his Heirs and Assigns forever, All that Messuages Tenement houses and Parcel of Land situate Lying & being in Southwarrington County in Virginia, Containing by Estimation One hundred & thirty five acres, more or less it being part of a tract left by Benjamin Johnson to his son Jeph which land has fell by descent to Joshua Johnson the surviving brother of the above Jeph Johnson and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Hickory standing by the side of Nottoway swamp; Thence along, line of marked Trees to a white Oak a corner tree, thence along a line to a pine a corner tree standing in a pond, Thence along a line to a white Oak a corner tree thence along a line to a white Oak a corner tree standing by a pond side Thence along a line to a white Oak standing in Nottoway swamp
