 to quiet and Discharge the said Joseph Scott from his heire

 wife hath granted Bargained sold set over All and Confirmed
 And by these presents Both Grant Bargain sold give and
 and Confirm above and Deliver unto the said Joseph Scott
 his heire and Aspigns forever all that Plantation & Improvement
 tract and parcell situated in the aforesaid County of South-
 ampton containing by Estimation One hundred and Ten acres
 more or less bounded by the known ancient & Reputed bounds
 therof Being the tract wheron I at present live, with
 all the Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise
 appertaining, and the reversion and Cessions, remainder
 and remainders, rents & issues profits Commodities
 hereditaments therof with the Estate Right Title Interest
 Claim or Demands of them the said Nathan Joyner &
 Priscilla his wife of me and the same or any part thereof
 To have and to hold the said Plantation & Improvement tract
 of One hundred and ten acres, more or less, unto him the said Joseph
 Scott Junr. his heirs & Aspigns forever to the only proper use
 & behoof of him the said Joseph Scott Junr. & no the said
 Nathan Joyner & Priscilla his wife, either heirs the said
 tract of one hundred & ten acres more or less, unto the said
 Joseph Scott Junr. his heirs & Aspigns forever, Against whom
 the said Nathan Joyner & Priscilla his wife &
 their Heirs and Aspigns, are against all persons whatsoever
 claiming or demanding the same shall & will warrant & forever
 Defend by these presents In Wiltshire, whereof the said Nathan
 Joyner and Priscilla his wife have hereunto set their hands
