Other part, Witnesseth, that the said Hardy
Royall Veltartha his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of seventy pounds Current Money of the State of
Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the signing, sealing
and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
said Hardy Royall Veltartha his wife doth hereby
acknowledge, And themselves thereof fully & entirely
satisfied Contented & Paid Have bargained sold aliened
enjoyed & confirmed and by these presents ~~and by these~~
presents doth hereby bargain sell alien enjoy & forever
confirm unto the said William Crutcher his heirs and
assigns forever, One certain tract of Plantation, or parcel of
Land &c.
