This INDENTURE made this 10th day of December in the year
of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and eighty four
Between Arthur Whitehead & Sally his wife of the County of
Southampton of the one part & William Whitehead of the other
County of the other part witnesseth that the said Arthur
Whitehead & Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
One thousand nine hundred pounds current money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said William Whitehead the
receipt whereof the said Arthur Whitehead & Sally his wife do
hereby acknowledge they the said Arthur Whitehead & Sally
his wife have given granted bargained & sold unto him & his wife
and by their presents do grant bargain and sell unto them & confirm
unto the said William Whitehead one certain tract or parcel
of land containing by estimation seven hundred & ten acres
situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the
North side of Rottaway River & bounded as is expressed in a
Patent granted to Henry Brown deceased bearing date the
thirteenth of March One thousand seven hundred & six
is the land purchased by Thomas Blunt deceased of the said
