This Indenture made this 16th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and eighty four Between Arthur Whitehead & Sally his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part & William Whitehead of the other County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur Whitehead & Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand nine hundred pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said William Whitehead the receipt whereof the said Arthur Whitehead & Sally his wife do hereby acknowledge they the said Arthur Whitehead & Sally his wife have given granted bargain'd & sold Alien & confirm and by these presents do grant bargain and sell Alien & confirm unto the said William Whitehead one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation seven hundred & fifteen acres situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the North side of Mattawamy River bounded as is Express'd in a Patent granted to Henry Browne Dec'd bearing date the thirtieth of March One thousand seven hundred & fifty five Vis the Land purchas'd by Thomas Blunt Dec'd of the said Henry
