This Indenture made, indented and agreed on

Southampton of the one part and Jordan Seddins of the same
County of the other part Witnesseth that the said James
Bailey & Briggs & Blowhale for and in consideration of a
certain negro fellow & Twenty five pounds lawful money of
Virginia hath granted bargain'd and sold Alien'd and
confirm'd and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell
alien and confirm unto the said Jordan Seddins one certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of
Southampton containing Two hundred and eighty three
more or less and bounded as appears by a deed from Wm.
Howells to John Bailey of said County and recorded in the
County Court of Southampton the 11 day of June One thousand
seven hundred and sixty one wherein the said ^{long} had wife

and remain'ds rents and services of the said premises Survey
past thereof and also all the estate right title Interest
