This Indenture made this Tenth day of March in the year
of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and Eighty five
Between Elizabeth Brantly and a Rebecca his wife of the
county of Southampton of the one part and William Hines
and John Powell of the same county of the other part Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds current
Money Virginia by the said William Hines and John Powell
to the said Elizabeth Brantly and Rebecca his wife in hand
paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof they doth acknowledge have granted bargained &
sold aliened and confirmed and by these doth grant bargain sell
alien release make over and confirm unto the said William Hines
and John Powell all their right title interest claim and demand
to and in one certain tract or parcel of land which was
purchased of Littleton Long by the said Elizabeth Brantly
Hines & John Powell containing by estimation three hundred
Hundred Acres —
