year of the Commonwealth and in the year of our Lord God One
Thousand seven hundred and Eighty five Between Benjamin
Barham of the County of Southampton of the one part and
Mary Murray of the same County of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Benjamin Barham for and in consideration
of the sum of One hundred & Whittun pounds Two Shillings
Sixpence money of Virginia to him in hand paid at & before
the Enacting and delivery of these presents by the said
Mary Murray the receipt whereof the said Benjamin
Barham doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit
and discharge the said Mary Murray her heirs Executors
and assigns by these presents he the said Benjamin
Barham hath granted bargain'd and sold alien'd &
confirm'd and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien & confirm unto the said Mary Murray her
heirs Executors & assigns a tract or parcel of land containing one
hundred & Whittun Acres of land lying and being in
the County of Southampton and on the south side of
the Cabin branch Joining the land the said Benj^m
Barham now then bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning at a Hickory corner of Arthur Wallers and
W^m Murrays and a fou and aff of Alexander Murray
Decast running along the Murrays Decast line north 23
