Between Samuel Sladeford & Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton & Parish of Netterway of the One part, & Samuel Slade the younger of the County & Parish aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth That the said Samuel Sladeford & Nancy his wife, for and consideration of the just full sum of Twenty five Pounds Current Money of Virginia by the said Samuel Slade to them in hand paid before the Ensealing & Delivery of these Presents, the Receipt whereof the said Samuel Sladeford and Nancy his wife, both hereby Acknowledge & thereof Acquit and Discharge the said Samuel Slade junior, his heirs & assigns forever, and themselves therewith fully & entirely satisfied Contented & Paid they the said Samuel Sladeford and Nancy his wife Have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed, released & our delivered & confirmed, and by these Presents both grant bargain sell alien, convey, release
