and Discharge the said Samuel Slade junior, his heirs &  
Assigns forever, and themselves therewith fully & entirely  
satisfied Contented & Paid they the said Samuel Sandford  
and Nancy his Wife Have granted bargained sold, given  
enjoyed, released & our delivered & confirmed, and by these  
Presents Doth grant bargain sell Alien, enjoy, receive &  
retain
