This Indenture Made this fourteenth Day of
July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & eighty five
Between William Master and Mary his
Wife, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
the One part and William Master joint of the County and State
of the other part Witneseth, that the said
William Master joint and Mary his wife for and Inconsi-
deration of the sum of Fifty pounds Current Money of the
State aforesaid, already in hand paid them, by the said
William Master joint before the unsealing & Delivery of these
presents, the receipt whereof they doth hereby Acknowledge
and themselves thereof fully & wholly Satisfied Contented
paid, Have Bargained, sold, Aliened, Infeoffed and
Confirmed, and by these presents doth hereby Bargain,
sell, Alien, Infeoff, and forever Confirm, unto the said
William Master joint his heirs, And Assigns, A Certain tract
& plantation or parcel of land lying in the parish of Millway
and County aforesaid, Beginning at a red oak a Corner
tree standing near the north west ^{corner} of the plantation, thence
and joining Largus both land, thence a west Corner tree
join, a Corner tree joining the same tract, thence near
a south house, to a sweet gum standing in a swamp
joining Robert Darden's land, thence up the swamp to
a Corner tree of Stall new garden, Benjamin
Baker, and Robert Darden, thence near a north
(east).
