 said Abraham Bradley his heirs, all & singular
 the premises hereby bargained sold, with the Expiration

 against him the said Abraham Bradley his heirs &
 all & every other person or persons whatsoever, shall warrant
 and forever defend by these presents, — And Lastly, that
 the said Abraham Bradley, and his heirs, and all and every
 other person or persons, and their heirs, any thing having
 or claiming in the premises herein before mentioned, or intended
 to be hereby bargained, sold, shall and, will from
 time to time, and at all times hereafter at the reasonable
 request, and at the proper Costs & Charges in the law of him
 the said John Simmons his heirs or Assigns, make do and
 execute or cause or procure to be made done & executed all
 and every such further & other Lawfull and reasonable Act,
 and All, thing and things, Conveyances and Assurances, for
 the better and More perfect Conveying and Assuring the
 Premises Aforesaid, with their and every of their Appurtena
