year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred eighty
six Between Moses Syner & Honour his wife of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and
William Pope of the County & State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth, that the said Moses Syner & Honour his wife
for and in Consideration of the sum of Forty pounds six
shillings current money of the state aforesaid, to them paid by the
said William Pope, at and before the sealing & delivery of
these presents, the receipt whereof they the said Moses Syner
and Honour his wife (both hereby acknowledge) and themselves
thereof fully and Intirely satisfied, contented & paid, Have
Bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoff'd & confirm'd, and by these
presents (both hereby, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff & confirm
confirm, unto the said William Pope his heirs and assigns,
one certain tract or plantation or parcel of Land, lying and
being situate in the parish of Nottoway and County aforesaid
on the south side of Nottoway swamp, bounded as follows
(to wit) Beginning, at a Gum a Corner tree, thence along a line
of marked trees to a pine, a corner tree, thence along a line of
marked trees to a Hickory a corner tree, joining Stephen Johnson
line, Thence along a line of marked trees, to a Gum a Corner tree
Thence, up Nottoway swamp to the first station, containing
by estimation, Eighty Acres be the same more or less, and
his part of a tract of Land that formerly belonged to Harry
Johnson. and by him devised to his son Matthew Johnson and
by the said Matthew Johnson, sold and conveyed unto Harry
