500. This Indenture made this 12th day of June in the
 Taylor being for of our lord One thousand seven hundred & eighty six
 Between Etheldred Taylor & Rebecca his wife of the one
 part and John Wright of the other part (all of the County of
 Southampton) Witnesseth, that the said Etheldred Taylor
 and Rebecca his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of
 One thousand pounds to them in hand paid by the said
 John Wright the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged
 They the said Etheldred Taylor & Rebecca his wife have
 Granted bargained and sold, aliened & Confirmed, and by
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien and Confirm,
 unto the said John Wright and to his heirs & assigns
 forever, all that plantation tract or parcel of land, whereon
 the said Etheldred Taylor now liveth, lying and being in the
 said County of Southampton on the south side of the three
 Creeks, containing by an Actual survey made by Sterling
 Foster, The twenty second Day of July last past, six
 hundred eighty eight and one half Acres, bounded as
 followeth to wit Beginning at a pine at the head of the
 gum branch thence down the various meanders of the said
 branch, six hundred and sixty one poles to the run of the
 Three Creeks aforesaid, then up the said Creek as it meanders
 seven hundred & sixteen poles to the Deep bottom, then up the
 said bottom as it meanders, One hundred & twenty nine
 poles to the road then down the said Road twenty seven
 poles to Mrs Mary Jorrell's line, then e along her line
 south forty nine degrees East One hundred & eighty four
 poles to a gum in the Indian branch, then up the said
 branch as it meanders, One hundred & thirty nine poles
 to a small White oak, a corner between the said Etheldred
