 whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof wherefrom Receipts are  
 discharged the said Thomas Murther his Exors. & Administrators by these  
 presents They the said Jell Murther Sally his wife Have granted  
 Bargained sold, and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff  
 and Confirm unto the said Thomas Murther his heirs and assigns  
 forever, One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the  
 County aforesaid Containing by estimation six teen Acres more  
 or less
