and Parish of Saint Luke of the one part, and Nathan Brett jun^r
of the County and Parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth,
that the said John Barrett for and in Consideration of the sum
of One hundred and eighty pounds Current money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said Nathan Brett at or before the
sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby
Acknowledged, the said Nathan Brett, the said John Barrett doth
hereby Acquit and discharge, Release, granted, bargained &
sell, and by these presents Doth fully and Absolutely grant
Bargain, sell, release and Convey unto him the said Nathan Brett
junior, his heirs and assigns One certain tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint
Luke, containing One hundred and Ninety Acres more or less and bounded
as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a pine in the line bet^w Edward
Brett's & John's land then along that line to a lightwood stump in
John Brett's line, a corner tree then along Del's line of pine, John
Rays corner then along Rays line to a pine, in Nicholas Brown's line,
standing in the line which was or is the line between Southampton
and Hants County, then along that line to a cedar Oak, a corner of
Edward Brett's land, then along the said Brett's line to a red Oak
another corner of the said Brett, then along his line to a pine,
(a corner)
