This Indenture, made this 15th Day of April in the year
of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and eighty six
Between James Moore eldest son an heir at Law of James
Moore late of the County of Southampton deceased of the one part
and Burwell Williamson of the same County of the other part
Whereas the said James Moore deceased in his life time did
enter into an agreement to Covenant to sell & Convey to the said
Burwell Williamson party hereto in fee simple for the
Consideration of Fifty pounds, One certain Tract or parcel of
Lands containing two hundred and fifty Acres, situated on the
South side of the main black water swamp in the said County
of Southampton, And whereas in performance of the said Agreement
the said James Moore deceased, did receive the whole of the
Consideration money as aforesaid, and then Deliver the possession
of the said Lands to the said Burwell Williamson, who by
virtue thereof hath hitherto enjoyed the same under the
Agreement aforesaid, but the said James Moore departed this
life before any deeds of Conveyance were made and executed,
to the said Burwell Williamson for the lands and premises
aforesaid, or his having in any other manner disposed of the
same, whereby the title in the said Lands by Law hath
descended and come to the said James Moore party hereto
as the eldest son and heir at Law of the said James Moore
deceased and the said James Moore the son being willing
