This Indenture, made the Tenth

one thousand seven hundred and Eighty and five, the first day of April, between Joseph Reese of Southampton County, Virginia, of the one part, and Richard Gilliam of the County of Southampton, Virginia, of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Joseph Reese for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds of lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Richard Gilliam at and before the executing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Joseph Reese doth hereby acknowledge. He the said Joseph Reese hath granted, bargained and sold, alienated, Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, confirm unto the said Richard Gilliam his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred and eighteen Acres (more or less) situate lying & being on the north side of Meherrin River in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning, at a Walnut in John E. Ridleys line thence nearly a most course to Gum in said Reeses line thence west one hundred and four poles to a red Oak in Benjamin P. Hoopes line, thence by the said Hoopes line, North fifty five Degrees, East one hundred and twenty six poles to a red Oak, a corner of a large Tellars land thence by the said Tellars line South fifty five Degrees East ninety four poles to a gum thence along the said Tellars line to a white Oak thence by the said Tellars line to a gum thence along a line a new marked trees to a maple in John E. Ridleys line thence along the said Ridleys line to the Beginning, with all woods under woods, profits commodities Advantages Emoluments and Hereditaments whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining in or upon the same growing, happening or arising and also the reversion and remain, remainder and remainders rents & services of the said premises and every part thereof. And all the estate right Title Interest claim and Demand of him the said Joseph Reese of in or to the same premises and every part thereof To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises, above mentioned & every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Richard Gilliam his heirs & assigns To the only use and behoof of him the said Richard Gilliam his heirs and assigns forever
