September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven
hundred and eighty six Between, John Blythe the
elder of the county of Southampton Parish of Nettoway
of the one part, and John Blythe the younger of the
County and Parish aforesaid of the other part Witness-
eth that the said John Blythe the eldest for and in
consideration of the just and full sum of Twenty pounds
Twelve shillings Current money of Virginia by the said
John Blythe the younger to him in hand paid before the
ensuing Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
the said John Blythe the elder doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Blythe the
younger his heirs and assigns forever, and himself fully &
sincerely satisfied contented and paid. Be the said John
Blythe the elder hath granted bargained, sold aliened
confeffed released set over delivered and Confirmed and
by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, confest
release set over deliver and Confirm unto the said John Blythe
