This Indenture, made this 20th day of march in the
year of our our Lord one thousand seven hundred Eighty six
Between, Titus Carr and Winiford Carr his wife
of the County of Dobbs and State of North Carolina, and
William Bryant of the County of Southampton & State of
Virginia Witnesses, that the said Titus Carr and
Winiford his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of
Two hundred & six pounds Current money of Virginia to him
in hand paid at or before the ^{en}sealing and Delivery hereof
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted
bargained sold, and by these presents Doth grant, bargain
sell alien & confirm unto the said William Bryant his
heirs and assigns; one certain tract or parcel of land lying
and being in Virginia and County of Southampton on
the south side of Mattowamy River, containing by estimation
Two hundred and six Acres and bounded as followeth (to wit)
Beginning at a pine corner tree of Etheldreda Everetts
standing in the line formerly Mansueto line, running
thence bearing on the said Everetts line south twenty nine
Degrees, east one hundred and fifty eight poles to a corner
