Know all men by men, by these presents that I
 Benjamin Waller of the county of Southampton, for and in
 consideration of the sum of seventy three pounds fourteen
 shillings to me in hand paid by, Arthur Waller of the
 said County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 Also for the further consideration of the sum of five
 shillings paid in the same manner — Have, granted
 Bargained & sold by these presents to grant bargain and sell
 unto the said Arthur Waller his heirs and assigns the
 following Negro slaves Viz: Isabella, Pips, and Toms —
 To have and to hold, the said Negro slaves and their
 increase unto the said Arthur Waller and his heirs to the only
 Proper use and behoof of him the said Arthur Waller his heirs
 and assigns forever, — Provided always & this instrument of
 Writing is on this Condition, That if the said Benjamin Waller
 his heirs &c. shall save harmless and indemnified the said
 Arthur Waller his heirs executors &c. from all Damages which
 he or they may sustain through the means of his the said
 Arthur Waller being security for the said Benjamin Waller's
 Paying Charles Edmunds of Southampton, the said sum of
 Seventy three Pounds fourteen shillings, as by their bond
 given to the said Charles Edmunds — may appear then
 this Instrument of Writing to be void, In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this ninth day of March 1786
