This Indenture made this 20th of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty six. Between Phileas Taylor of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and James McNeal of said County and State of Virginia Merchant of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Five shillings to the said Phileas Taylor by the said James McNeal in hand paid
