Gold, Two Penny Weight, or Six Shillings and Eight
Pence Two Pence in Silver, to the which pay made well
and truly to be made & done, I bind myself, my Heirs,
Executors Administrators or Assigns firmly by these
Presents, sealed with my Seal & Dated this 18th Day
of March One Thousand seven hundred & Eighty Six,

The Condition of the above obligation is such
that whereas the above named William Wester Jun^r
and Mary his wife, in the Month of September Uixxx
of 1785, sold and Conveyed unto the above bound William
Wester Jun^r a certain tract Plantation a barl of land
Lying & being Situate in the said County of Spots
-tan and parish of Riddimay, And is the same tract
and Plantation the aforesaid William Wester Jun^r
and Mary his wife then (and now) Occupying,
And the said William Wester Jun^r being desirous and
Perfectly Willing (as was agreed at the time of the Convey
ance of the same & premises) to admit and allow the
said William Wester Jun^r & Mary his wife, the
Liberty and Priviledges of still Holding enjoying &
Occupying During their Natural Lives, As much of
the said land tenements Hereditaments and appurte
nances, especially the apple orchard & such cleared
Corn Grounde as they shall choose, as now is & here
after will be necessary towards their support, and
the said William Wester Jun^r for himself his Heirs
exors. & assigns, Doth hereby & Grant unto the
said William Wester Jun^r & Mary his wife
the free Priviledges aforesaid to them, free and
Indepenant, without the Motivation of him the said
William Wester Jun^r or any other Person claiming by
or under him, &c that due Performance of the
Covenants aforesaid, that then the above obligation to be
Void or else to remain in full force power and vertue
