Pursuant and agreeable to the last will and  
testament of James Jordan Scott Deceased, He proceeded to  
make a division of the negroes that belonged to the estate of the  
said deceased, And have divided them into five equal distinct  
and separate parts & Partitions as follows to wit Robin, Venus,  
Celia & Rachel compose the first Lot or one fifth part  
of all the said Negroes which negroes Meriam Scott widow  
of the said James Jordan Scott did make choice of as and  
for her full share and proportion of all the said negroes.  
And the second Lot being also the fifth part of the whole  
and which consists of negroes Old Mill, Sue, young Mill,  
and Fanny, are by Lot assigned to Saml Scott as her  
full share & proportion of the said Negroes, And the  
third Lot being another fifth part consisting of Negroes  
Pompy, Sam, Don, & Cherry are in like manner assigned to  
James Scott for his full share & proportion of all the  
said Negroes, And the fourth Lot or next fifth part  
being Negroes Eddy, Leary, Mounning, & Tall, are by Lot  
assigned to Robert Abbott, as his full share and  
proportion of the whole, And the last fifth part or fifth  
Lot, consisting of Negroes Rose, Jerry, Frederick and  
Lucy are likewise assigned to Sarah Scott for her  
full share & proportion of all the said Negroes, Given  
under our hands & seals the 25th day of February Anno domini  
1786.
