 bearing date the twentieth day of August one thousand seven
 hundred and forty, and the said John Battle for himself
 for any other person claiming under him the said land and
 promises & every part thereof shall and lawfully warrant and
 defend unto the aforesaid Eldredes Warren his heirs executors
 administrators assigns In Witness whereof the said John Battle
 hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the
 Day and year above written
