

This Indenture Made this 14th day of June 1789
 Between John Johnson Senr. and Mourning his wife of the one part, &
 John Johnson Senr. of the Parish of Saint John, the one part, &
 John Johnson Senr. of the Parish of Saint John, and County
 of the other part, **WITNESSETH**, that the
 said John Johnson Senr. and Mourning his wife for and in
 consideration of the sum of Five shillings to them in
 hand paid by the said John Johnson Senr. at or before
 the making & delivery of these presents, the receipt
 whereof the said John Johnson Senr. & Mourning his
 wife doth hereby acknowledge, I thereof acquit &
 discharge the said John Johnson Senr. his heirs, Executors,
 and Administrators forever, by these presents, they,
 the said John Johnson Senr. and Mourning his wife
 hath granted, Bargained, sold, aliened, released &
 confirmed, and by these presents, **Doth**, Grant,
 Bargain, sell, alien, release & confirm unto the said
 John Johnson Senr. his heirs & assigns forever, one
 Plantation part of a ~~part of~~ certain parcel of land
 situate, lying & being on the south side of Netemay River,
 bounded by the lands of John T. Bloor, Ben Williams, and of
 Thomas Williams, and separated from the plantation whereon
 the said John Johnson Senr. now lives, by a small Branch
 which runs across the said Tract of Land & then runs
 through Thomas Williams Plantation, The said plantation
 part of a Tract or parcel of Land, supposed to contain, one
 hundred acres, more or less, now in the Tenure & Occupation
 of the said John Johnson Senr. and has been for ten or fifteen
 years past, Together with all houses out houses, edifices
 Buildings, woods, ways, water Courses, Waters Lowgrounds
 Profits Commodities Hereditaments & Appurtenances what-
 soever, And the reversion and reversions, Remainder and
 Remainders, Rents Issues & Profits Thereof, and all the
 state, right, Title, Interest, use, Trust, Proposition, Property
 Benefit Claim & Demand of them the said John Johnson Senr.
 and Mourning his wife of in & to the same, any and every
 part
