This Indenture Made and given this 11th day of
February in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred &
eighty six, Between, Mills Herring, Ann his Wife, and
Elizabeth Wilson of the one part, and William Thomas ally of
the State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that
the said Mills Herring, Ann his wife, & Elizabeth Wilson for
and in consideration of the sum of eighty pounds to them in
hand paid, by the said William Thomas, the Receipt whereof
they do hereby acknowledge and thereof do release account &
discharge the said William Thomas, his heirs and assigns
forever, by their presents that the said Mills Herring & Ann
his wife, and Elizabeth Wilson have bargained sold and
conveyed, and by these presents do bargain sell & deliver unto
William Thomas his heirs & assigns forever, one certain tract or
parcel of Land, lying and being in the County of Southampton
and State aforesaid known & distinguished by the said Mills
of the four Vach places containing One hundred and
fifty acres, which said Land was given & conveyed
