Whereas Miles Herring, and Ann his wife, and Elizabeth
Wilson have by their Certain Indenture of bargain, Sale,
Dated the 11th day of February 1786. sold and conveyed the
free simple estate of and in one Certain tract or parcel of
Land situate, lying & being in the County of Southampton
Containing one hundred & fifty Acres to William Thomas
and Whereas the said Ann Herring the wife of the said Miles
Herring cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County
to relinquish her right of Power in the Same, as the Law
directs. - These are Therefore to command you or any two or
more of you, personally to go to the said Ann & examine her
privately and apart from her said husband, whether she hath
received the dues hereto annexed without the persuasion or
threats of her said husband, & whether she is willing that the
same should be recorded in the Court of our said County of
Southampton, and when you have examined her as aforesaid that
you distinctly & plainly certify us thereof under your hands
