This Indenture made this fourteenth day of December One Thousand seven hundred and eighty six Between Matthew Lobb & Margaret Lobb his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and Abraham Mitchell of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Matthew Lobb and Margaret his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of twenty pounds lawful money of the State aforesaid already in hand paid them by the said Abraham Mitchell, the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge, and themselves thereof fully satisfied Contented and paid, have bargained sold Aliened enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm, unto the said Abraham Mitchell his Heirs and Assigns, A Certain Tract parcel or piece of Land lying, and being situate on the North side of Mattoway River, in the parish of Mattoway, and county aforesaid bounded as followeth (Viz) Beginning at a small lightwood stump standing on the west side of and near to the Doctors Road a corner
