Honing, and Richard Edwards, Gentlemen. Whereas Micajah Holliman
and Mary his wife by their certain indenture bearing date the fifteenth day
of November 1786. have sold and conveyed unto Benjamin ~~White~~ White of
the County of Southampton the fee simple Estate of and in one certain
Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the said County of
Southampton containing by estimation five hundred & ten acres more
or less. And whereas the said Mary cannot conveniently travel to
the Court of our said County to make acknowledgement thereof

Therefore we do give unto you or any two or more of you power to receive
the acknowledgement which the said Mary may be willing to make
of her dower in the lands conveyed by the said indenture: Therefore
we command you or any two of you to go personally to the said
Mary and receive her acknowledgement of the same, and examine
her privately and apart from her said husband whether she
doth the same voluntarily and freely without the persuasion or
threats of her said husband, and whether and whether she is
willing the same should be recorded in the County Court of
Southampton and when you have examined as aforesaid that
you distinctly and plainly certify us thereof under your hand
and seals, returning unto us also this writ witness Samuel
Kello Clerk of our said Court at his Office this 20th day of
November 1786 in the 11 year of our Independence
