even hundred and eighty seven between Thomas Williams and
Winnefred his wife of the Parish of St. Lukes and County of
Southampton of the one part and Amos Stephenson of the
Parish of St. Lukes and County aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Williams and Winnefred
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
& fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Amos
Stephenson at or before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas Williams and
Amos Stephenson for the sum of £150 paid by his wife Winnefred his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened
released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said
Amos Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever one plantation
tract or certain parcel of land situated lying and being in the
County of Southampton on the south side of a Nottaway River
and bounded as follows to wit Beginning on the north side
of Tuckwathurst swamp at John Williams land uppon of
Jacob Williams tract thence running up a branch to a Maple
tree thence to a white oak a corner tree from thence to
a red oak in Benjamin Williams line upon thereof to a
