This Indenture made this sixth day of Feb^r in the year
of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and eighty seven
between Jesse Bazel of the parish of Chiltonway & County of
Southampton of the one part, & Jonathan Gay of the same parish
and County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Bazel
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty-five pounds current
money of Virginia to him in hand by the said Jonathan Gay
at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the
receipt whereof the said Jesse Bazel doth hereby acknowledge
& thereof acquit and discharge the said Jonathan Gay his
heirs and assigns by these presents, hath granted bargained
and sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed & by
these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release
enfeoff & confirm unto the said Jonathan Gay & to his
heirs and assigns part of the tract of Land whereon
he now lives lying in the County aforesaid containing
fifty acres more or less, and bounded as followeth, beginning
at a corner tree a fence, thence along Branches line to
Washington's line, thence along Washington's line to
Cokers line thence along Cokers line to Brittles line
thence along Brittles line to a corner white oak thence
along a new line to the beginning, the reversion and reversions
remainder and remainders unto issues and profits thereof
and also the estate right title interest whatsoever of him.
