seven hundred & eighty seven Between James Ince and Mary his
wife of the County of Southampton in the Colony of Virginia of
the one part and Etheldred Taylor of the aforesaid County and
Colony of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Ince
and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
seventy-five pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand
paid by the said Etheldred Taylor at or before the sealing of
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James
Ince and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof
acquit and discharge the said Etheldred Taylor his heirs
Exors and Admrs forever by these presents They the said James
Ince and Mary his wife Hath granted bargained sold aliened
released and confirm'd and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien release and confirm unto the said Etheldred Taylor
his heirs and assigns forever All that the said James Ince his
plantation tract or parcel of lands situated lying and being on
the south side of great ploughman Swamp in the Colony
aforesaid and in the Parish of St. Lukes and County of Southampton
containing one hundred acres be the same more or less bounded as
followeth To wit on the north by great ploughman Swamp
on the west by John Grizzards land on the south by Benjamin Adams
