This Indenture made this eighth day of December in the fourth year of the said thirteen hundred & eighty seven Benjamin Johnson and eldest his wife of Southampton County in the State of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Gray of the said county & State of the other part Witnesseth that we expressed Jesse Altkison and Wiley his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds lawfully money to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Gray receipt whereof the said Jesse Altkison and Wiley his wife doth hereby acknowledge & herof him doth requit hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said Benjamin Gray his heirs &c. one tract parcel or dividend of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid county it being the plantation whereon I formerly lived, containing seventy-five acres be the same more or less, bounded as followeth (to wit) begining at a pine a corner tree of William Whiteheads land then along the said Whiteheads line to a pine another corner tree of the said Whiteheads then along the said Whiteheads line to a red oak a corner tree of William Newtons land then along the said Newtons line to a pine a corner tree of Jesse Johnsons land then along the said Johnsons to a black oak a corner tree of the said Johnsons standing in William Whiteheads line then along the said Whiteheads line to the begining, with all woods under woods swamps marshes meadows fields & his dues shear of vines mines and all other appurtenances thereto & also the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rents & services of the said premises and every part thereof and all the estate right title interest
