This Indenture made this 15th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven Between Richard Ricks and Julia his wife of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part; and William Cricklow of the County aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Richard Ricks and Julia his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy pounds sixteen Shillings and eight pence current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Cricklow at the time of the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; have given granted bargained and sold, conveyed and confirmed; and by these presents do fully freely and absolutely give grant bargain and sold convey and confirm unto the said William Cricklow his heirs and assigns a certain tract parcel of land situate lying and being in the parish of Nettoway in County aforesaid and bounded as follows (Viz.) Beginning at a Pine standing on Ricks's path in Anne Ricks's line running by her line North 70 degrees East 34 pole to a Pine then South 75th East 31 pole to a willow Oak over flag branch a corner of Samuel Ricks's and the
