the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
eighty seven Between Matthew Vick Sen^r and Sarah his
wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the
one part, and Charles Hinecock Birdsong of the same County
and State aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth that the
said Matthew Vick Sen^r and Sarah his wife, for and in con-
sideration of the sum of one hundred pounds current money of
the State aforesaid, to them in hand paid by the said Charles
H. Birdsong at and before the enrolling and delivery of these
presents, the receipt whereof they the said Matthew Vick
Sen^r and Sarah his wife doth hereby acknowledge and themselves
thereof fully satisfied, contented and paid, have bargained sold
aliened and enfeofed and confirmed, and by these presents
doth hereby bargain sold alien enfeof and forever confirmed
the said Charles H. Birdsong his heirs and assigns a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being situate in the parish
of St. Lukes and county of Southampton and bounded as follows
