This Indenture made this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven. Between Matthew Wells and Mary his wife of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Stephen Pope of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Matthew Wells and Mary his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds current money of Virginia already in hand paid them by the said Stephen Pope, at and before the enscaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said Matthew Wells and Mary his wife, doth hereby acknowledge and themselves thereof fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid, have bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm unto the said Stephen Pope his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situate in the county of Southampton and State aforesaid on the North side of Kottoway River and bounded as followeth, (to wit) Beginning at a red Oak a corner tree of Samuel Cobbs and Jesse Browns thence South eighteen degrees East forty two poles to a sweet Gum, thence South thirty two degrees East
