their certain indenture bearing date the 11th day of January
1787 have sold and conveyed unto Stephen Wincke the fee
simple estate of and in eighty five acres of land situate in
the parish of Saint Luke and county of Southampton on
the South side of Mattunoy River and whereas the said
Elizabeth cannot conveniently travel to our Court of our
said county of Southampton to make her acknowledg-
ment of the said conveyance contained in the said
indenture Therefore we do give unto you or any two or more
of you power to receive the acknowledgment which the
said Elizabeth shall be willing to make before you of
the conveyance aforesaid which is hereto annexed and
we do therefore command you that you personally go to the
said Elizabeth and receive her acknowledgment of the same
and examine her privately and apart from the said Daniel
Story her husband whether she doth the same freely and
voluntarily without his persuasion or threats and whether she
be willing the same should be recorded in the Court of our
said county and when you have received her acknowledgment
and examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly and openly
certify us thereof in our said Court under your seals and sig-
