This Indenture made this seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty one Between Joseph Marks and Richard Marks executors of David Barker of the last will and testament of William Barker dec^d. of the county of Southampton of the one part and Joel Newson of the parish of St. Lukes and county aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph and Richard Marks and David Barker pursuant to the last will and testament of the said William Barker dec^d. hath for the consideration of two hundred and fifty one pounds current money to them in hand paid by said Joel Newson at or before the sealing and delivery thereof hath bargained sold aliened, released, conveyed, confirmed, and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain sell alien, release and convey firm unto the said Joel Newson, his heirs and assigns all that certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the parish aforesaid, and county of Southampton on the North side of the Three Creeks on the Horner swamp, containing one hundred and seventy seven acres be the same more or less and bounded according to the known and reputed bounds thereof; the same being one third part of a certain tract or parcel of land containing five hundred
