John Simmons son of William of the parish of Mottaway in the town
of Southampton of the one part and Benjamin Blunt of the parish
of Saint Luke in the same county esquire of the other part Witnesseth
That as well for the purpose of securing the said Benjamin Blunt
as assignee on a certain bond bearing date the twenty ninth day of
April one thousand seven hundred and eighty six given by the said

by the said Lewis Joiner endorsed or assigned to the said Benjamin
Blunt and by him assigned to Lot and Thigby merchants
