Hundred and Fifty three pounds seven shillings & pence of Virginia to him
in hand paid by the said Thomas Dixley at and before the
drawing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof of the
said John Holladay doth here by acknowledge & whereof doth
acquit and discharge the said Thomas Dixley, his heirs Executors &
Administrators by these presents hath granted bargain sold alien
releas'd and confirm'd and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien Release and confirm unto the said Thomas Dixley his
heirs and assigns forever an certain tract parcel or Division
of Land situate lying & being in the county afore said containing
Three hundred & forty Acres and bounded as followeth to wit
beginning at two pines by the sides of the Brushy Pond then South
Whitum Digues west twenty poles to a Black Oak sapling in
