This Indenture made this tenth day of August in the
 Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred Eighty seven Between
 William Harrison of the County of Essex of the one part & John Lawrence of the
 County of Isle of Wight of the other part Witneseth that for and in
 Consideration of the sum of fifty Five pounds current money of Virginia
 the said William Harrison in hand paid by the said John Lawrence
 the receipt whereof the said William Harrison doth hereby acknowledge
 and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Lawrence his heirs
 executors and administrators have granted bargained sold alured
 released and confirmed by these presents do grant bargain sell
alien release and confirm unto the said John Lawrence his heirs
 his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying
 and being in the said county of Southampton Black water River
 containing three hundred and seventy one acres and bounded
 as followeth Beginning at a gum on the Mirey branch thence
 south eighty one degrees East one hundred & fourty poles to a pine
 Thence south sixty degrees east sixty nine poles to a pine thence
 South seventy four degrees east twelve poles to a small hickory
 Thence north two degrees west thirty six poles to a small red oak
 Thence north thirty two degrees west to a red oak thence along
 Joshua Whitneys line to Black water River thence down the
 meanders of the said River to the upper side of Clowes Island
 thence along the upper side of the said Island to the mouth of
 of the mirey branch and thence up the meanders of the said branch
 to the beginning which said tract of land the said William Harrison
 George Thomas White purchased of William Glover by Indenture
 bargain and sale bearing date tenth day of August 1768 and
 the reverions reversion remainder and remaining rents issues
 and profits thereof and also all the estate right title & interest
 of him the said William Harrison his heirs and assigns of mortis
 the said tract or parcel of land and every part and parcel
 thereof to have and to hold the said three hundred & twenty
 one acres of land and premises with the appurtenances unto
 the said John Lawrence his heirs and assigns to the only justly
 the said William Harrison for himself & his heirs do convenient
 promises and agreements and with the said
