This Indenture made this 13th Day of September in the Year of our Lord 1787 Between Carr Doyle and Charity Doyle his wife of the county of Southampton and Parish of Netley of the one part and John Carstarphen of the parish and county aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Carr Doyle and Charity his wife for and in Consideration of the just and full sum of thirty five pounds current Money of Virginia by the said John Carstarphen to them in hand at or before the concealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt where of the said Carr Doyle and Charity his wife ^{seth} hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit and discharge the said John Carstarphen in his heirs and assigns for ever and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid & by the said Carr Doyle & Charity his wife have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver and confirm unto the said John Carstarphen
