This Indenture made the seventeenth day of November in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven Between David Denson and Judith Denson his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Helway of the one part and Daniel Rusfel of the County of Stafford and of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Denson and Judith his wife for in consideration of the just full sum of one Hundred Pounds Current money of Virginia by the sd Daniel Rusfel to them in hand paid before the making & delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said David Denson and his wife doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Daniel Rusfel his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid They the said David Denson & his wife have Granted Bargained sold Alien'd enfeoffed Released sover Delivered and Conformed and by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff Release release deliver & confirm unto the said Daniel Rusfel and to his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation Messuage Tract & parcel of Land whereon the said David Denson & Judith his wife now live situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Helway aforesaid containing by Estimation one hundred and Twenty four Acres be the same more or Less and Bounded as follows *Witt* Beginning at a Poplar standing in a small Branch in Fore Measur & formerly Georges Councils line thence the said Drapors line down the run of the said Branch to the line Branch thence up the said line Branch to the head thereof and from thence a line of Marked Trees which divider the sd Lands from David Densons then lands to a corner Tree & still the said line to Richard Popes late Henry Popes line thence the said line to a Dead Oak in prudence Clarks line standing on the Lusher Road Thence said line down the said Road to a Pine &
