This Indenture made this Eighth day of November 25.
A.D. 1813, Between James Clark and Susanah his wife of the County of Southampton of
the one part and Harmon Harri of the other part of the County of
Winnebago that the said James Clark and Susanah his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current Money of Virginia to
them in hand paid at or before the sealing and Delivering of these
present the receipt whereof the said James Clark and Susanah his wife
doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied Contented and paid
both granted Bargained sold Alien in feoffed and Confirmed and
by these presents doth grant Bargain sell Alien in feoffment confirm
unto the said Harmon Harri and to his heirs and assigns forever all
that Tract of Land and premises with the appurtenances situate lying and
being in the County of Southampton which I shd by Will of
the last will and Testament of my Father containing of the said fifty
Acres more or less and lying on the south side of the main black water
swamp and bounded as follows Beginning in Warwick branch at the mouth
of the bog branch thence up the various Courses of the bog branch to
a white oak corner of Burwell Williamson & H. Harri's land thence
along the said Harri's and Williamson's line to a white oak by
the side of Joseph's Pico's a corner of the said Harri's thence
along the S. Line to a pine in Warwick Branch thence down the
various Courses of the said branch to the beginning also all
woods under woods ways water and water courses with all
profits Commodities and advantages whatsoever to the same
belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the Curson
and reversion remainder a Remainder rents and services
of the said premises and every part and parcel thereof
also all the estate right title interest claim or demand what
soever of them the said James Clark and Susanah his wife of
in and to the same premises and every part thereof To have
and To hold all and singular the said premises above
mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with
the appurtenances unto the Harmon Harri his heirs &
assigns To the only proper use and behoof of him the
said Harri his heirs and assigns forever And so
