

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of
 December in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven
 hundred and Eighty seven Between Giles Joyner and Margaret
 his wife William Joyner & Mary his wife of the County of
 Southampton parish of Netaway of the one part and Henry
 Jones of the same County and parish aforesaid of the other
 part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the just
 and full sum of one hundred and Twenty Pounds cleve
 ent money of Virginia by the said Henry Jones to them
 In Land paid before the executing and delivering of these
 presents the receipt whereof the said Giles Joyner & Margaret
 his wife William Joyner & Mary his wife doth hereby declare
 knowledge and thereof acquit & Discharge the d. Henry
 Jones his heirs and assigns forever and themselves therewith
 fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid they the d. Giles
 Joyner and Margaret his wife William Joyner and Mary
 his wife have granted bargained sold aliened infeoffed
 released set over Delivered & confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell alien infeoff release set over deliver
 and confirm unto the said Henry Jones and to his heirs &
 assigns forever all that plantation meadowe Tract and
 parcel of Land wherein the said Giles and William Joyner
 now lives situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
 and parish of Netaway aforesaid containing by Estimation
 One hundred and Twenty Acres be the same more or less
 and bounded as follows to wit beginning in Joseph Densons
 line at a gum a corner Tree of the said Land standing in
 the cattail swamp thence the said Densons line to a
 red oak on the road thence the line which divides the
 said Land from the said William Joyners other lands down
 the said Road to a white oak; still the said road to a small
 holly another corner of the said Land thence to a
 Persimmon in the old field another corner of the said
 Land thence to a post another corner thereof
