

Lying and being in the county of Southampton containing by estimation sixty acres more or less & when as the said Susanna cannot conveniently travel to the court of our said county to make acknowledgment of the same Therefore we do give unto you or any two or more of you Power to receive the acknowledgment which the ^d Susanna maybe willing to make of her dower in the lands conveyed by the said indenture Therefore we Command You or any two of you to go personally to the said Susanna & receive her acknowledgment of the same & examine her privately and apart from her said husband, Whether she doth the same Voluntarily and freely without the persuasion or threats of her ^d husband & whether she is willing that the same should be Recorded in the County court of Southampton & when you have examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly and plainly Certify as thereof under your hands and seals returning unto us also this writ Witness Sam^l Kello Clark of our ^d Court at his Office the 25th Day of July 1787 in the 1st Year of the Commonwealth
