This Indenture made this Ninth day of March
in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven hundred
and eighty six Between William Butts & Mary his wife
of the County of Southampton of the one part and William Hines
of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
William Butts & Mary his wife for and in Consideration of
the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds current money of
Virginia to them in hand paid the Receipt whereof they do hereby
acknowledge hath granted Bargained & sold aliened conveyed
and confirmed and by these Presents doth grant Bargain
and sell alien enfeoffed and confirm unto the said William
Hines & his heirs &c. all that Tract or parcel of land situated
lying and being in the County of Southampton in the west end
of the Asamooch swamp and Bounded as followeth to
wit Beginning at a live Oak on the west side of the Asam-
ooch swamp a corner of Peter Butts is Land & thence along
the said line west by North three hundred & thirty pole
to a pine a corner Tree of Peter Butts a foresaid then south
six degrees East Two hundred pole to a red oak sapling a
corner tree of Charles Simmons then east by south three
hundred and Twenty pole to three Trees Chopped in woods
by the side of the Asamooch swamp a foresaid thence
up the various Courses of the Run of the said swamp to
the Beginning containing five hundred acres be the
James Moore or Less which said Land was Divided to
the said William Butts by the last Will and Testament
of his father Peter Butts and Purchased by the said Peter
Butts of Peter Hines and by the said Hines of Ruben Cook
and by the said Cook of William Simmons of Surrey
County and by the said Simmons of the chiefs men of the
Mattaway Indian Nation with all houses build-
ings orchards lands woods ways waters and advantages
whatsoever to the said Land and premises now at
