 Witnesseth that the sd. Jacob Johnson for and in consideration
 of the just & full sum of Fifty Five Pounds
 current money of Virginia by the Solomon Worrell
 to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents The Receipt whereof the said Jacob
 Johnson doth hereby acknowledge and therefore
 and discharge the sd. Solomon Worrell his heirs Executors
 Administrators Assigns forever and himself of these
 said Jacob Johnson hath granted Bargained sold
 aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered conveyed
 and by these presents doth grant Bargain sell alien
 release set over Deliver and confirm unto the
 Solomon Worrell and to his heirs Assigns forever all
 that plantation Messuage Tract & Parcel of Land
 Whereon Josiah Johnson formerly lived containing
