bargain & sell alien enfeof and forever confirm unto
the s^d. Pilgrim Wick his heirs & assigns a certain messuage
plantation tract or parcel of land situate lying & being
in the county aforesaid containing by Estimation
One hundred & fifty Acres be the same more or less
